


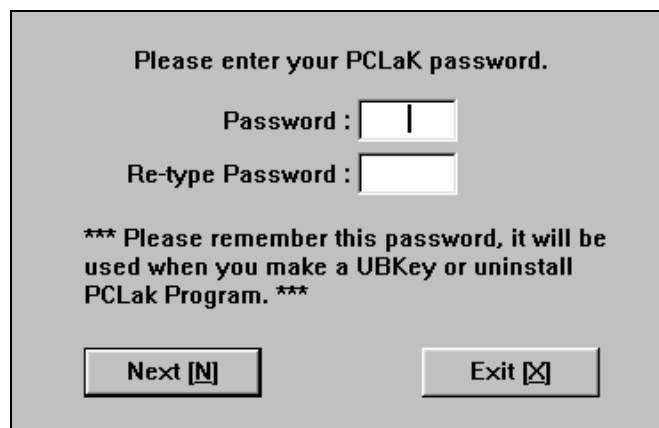




USB Installation Instructions

1. Insert  Pkey (Master Key) into an USB interface on your computer. Use USB extension cord for easier Pkey insertion/removal.
2. Turn on the computer and enter Windows OS mode. If you are using Windows NT/2000/XP, you will need to sign-in with administrator privilege.
3. Insert  Installation CD into your CD-ROM drive.
4. Click on “Start” button on Windows, and select “Run” from the Windows menu.
5. Type “E:\SETUP”, and press Enter key to start  software installation.
Note: E: is main your CD-Rom driver letter
6. This picture will appear on the screen:




Click on the “Next” button, and the next screen will appear to ask for new password:




What you enter will become your  password. This password is very important, and you should not lose it. The password is necessary for unlocking  as well as copying an UBKey (spare key).

Note: As a reminder, please do not forget your  password. Otherwise you will not be able to unlock .

7. After entering and reconfirming the unique password, click on the “Next” button to finish installation. The installation program will restart Windows, and upon completion,  will be installed on your computer.

Please refer to the User’s Manual inside the  CD for  usage instructions.

Recommendation:

The Pkey (Master Key) is included in the standard  package. Please keep the Pkey in a safe place. You will need to reinstall your Windows OS if you lose the Pkey. We recommend that you purchase an UBKey (Spare Key / Option), and use the UBKey to manage your computer. This will prevent the Pkey from getting lost and will avoid the potential problem mentioned above.
